Complaints of discrimination, discriminatory harassment, sexual harassment and sex and gender based violence can be reported to CCR. An investigation into Executive Policy 15 violations are separate from the criminal process, and can be pursued simultaneously. CCR works closely with Human Resource Services (HRS) for employee matters and the Center for Community Standards (CCS) for student matters. CCR shares investigative information on a need-to-know basis, but cannot guarantee confidentiality.
